

Basic Documents Required During Visa Interview

1. **International Passport** must have a validity period of at least (6) six months at the date of entry into Israel.
2. Non-refundable fee (Please visit our fee chart page).
3. Two coloured passport sized photographs (**5cm x 5cm**) on white background.
4. Show evidence of employment or business activity; e.g. Letter of Employment; Business Incorporation/Registration and any other evidence of business undertaking.
5. Statement of account for 6months (Corporate accounts) plus 6 months for personal accounts. Personal Accounts holders only require 6months statements. (Corporate accounts holders must show proof of ownership of the business and be signatories to the account(s).
6. Make a **reservation for Hotel and Airline flight** and bring along the confirmation.
7. Any other documents to support your application. (a) Medical cases must show letter of appointment with the hospital in Israel and in addition, a medical report from a local hospital in Nigeria.

(b) **Applicants travelling with children under 18years of age must show birth certificates endorsed by the Legal Dept. of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Nigeria.**

(c) Other applicants to show proof of purpose for the visit in support of their application.

NOTE: APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN PERSON & PROCESSING TAKES 14 WORKING DAYS.
