You will also partake in lectures and cocktail events as part of the DLD Tel Aviv Innovation Festival – Israel's largest international Technology and Creativity gathering, featuring hundreds of startups, investors and leading multinational. The festival compiles over 100 events throughout the city in the last week of September (http://dldtelaviv.com/).

The DLD will provide an unparalleled opportunity to tap into the innovative ecosystem in Tel Aviv and to interact with key figures in the hi-tech industry in Israel and worldwide. You will also participate in the Cities Summit – an internationally known conference featuring lectures and workshops on urban development and innovation.

This year the Cities Summit will include a special session specifically focused on the technological and institutional solutions to urban challenges in developing countries.
