Scientists at Migal will benefit from a young, stimulating and competitive research environment as well as a joint teaching position at the Faculty of Sciences at Tel-Hai Academic College. New principal investigators will receive attractive startup funding for establishing their new labs and will be expected to carry out independent research programs and to submit proposals for research grants.

Candidates towards the end of their post-doctoral period who have demonstrated excellence in research are encouraged to apply. Initial applications should include Curriculum Vitae, a list of publications and a short summary of the candidate's future research plans (up to 1 page).

Migal is also offering a new research group leader-Entrepreneur track, designed to help researchers with applied research projects and bring them to proof-of-concept and commercialization. Participants will benefit from a principle investigator position in an academic environment, while receiving funding and professional guidance from the Migal Innovation Lab to pursue their idea.
