## Birth Certificate (Hebrew/English)

This service is available for citizens / non-citizens who were born in Israel.

Please note: records of those born in Israel before the establishment of the state or between the years 1919-1955 are limited and receiving documentation for them takes longer than usual- at least 8-12 weeks. Be patient with these requests.

## **Required Documents:**

- 1. <u>Birth certificate request form</u>- Completed and Signed:
  - When requesting a birth certificate in English, please fill out the application form in English and write down your preference for a birth certificate in Hebrew/English.
  - o Specify whether you want to verify the certificate with an apostille stamp.
  - When applying for a birth certificate for individuals under the age of 18, please complete the upper part of the form with the details of the adult applicant and the lower part with the details of the minor.
- 2. Photocopy of an Israeli Passport:
  - When applying for a birth certificate for individuals under the age of 18, attach passport photos of the adult applicant and the minor for whom the certificate is being ordered.
- **3.** Bank transfer confirmation (<u>fee chart</u> + <u>bank transfer details</u>):
  - o The certificate is issued free of charge.
  - Apostille stamp if needed
  - o postage fees within Australia
- **4.** Full postage address within Australia after receiving the certificate + contact information (Mobile number + Email address)
