Certificate showing Israeli Citizenship (Hebrew/English)

Required Documents:

- 1. <u>Citizenship Certificate Request Form</u> Completed and Signed:
 - o Indicate if you want to verify the certificate with an apostille stamp
 - The request form should be fully completed and signed by the applicant. There are two methods for signing the application form:
 - i. Method 1: In person at the consular department.
 - ii. Method 2: In front of a notary public and an <u>apostille stamp from DFAT</u>.
- 2. Photocopy of an Israeli Passport:
 - Method 1: Signed by the consular section
 - Method 2: Signed by a notary public
- **3.** Bank transfer confirmation (<u>fee chart</u> + <u>bank transfer details</u>):
 - o A fee is needed for the issuance of this certificate
 - o Apostille stamp if needed
 - o postage fees within Australia
- **4.** Full postage address within Australia after receiving the certificate + contact information (Mobile number + Email address)

Additional Comments:

- If the application form is signed at the embassy (Method 1), you are required to book an appointment before visiting with an Israeli passport and a completed application form.
- If the application form is signed in front of a notary public with an <u>apostille stamp</u> (Method 2), the application must be sent by registered mail to the consular department:
