

Who can apply?	Documents required
<p>Anyone with first-degree family members <u>currently living in Israel</u> (parents, children, siblings, spouses – citizens or residents. <b>NO STUDENTS VISA HOLDERS</b>) , who is <b>vaccinated with two doses</b> or has <b>antibodies</b>, is eligible to submit a request to enter Israel (for themselves, spouse and children, if <u>all have been vaccinated/have antibodies</u>)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of your first-degree family member's Israeli passport. For residents only (no Israeli passport) please provide a copy of your passport + visa</li> <li>3. Proof of a family connection must be made by sending a Birth Certificate with both parents' names as proof and marriage certificate</li> <li>4. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>5. If Vaccinated - You must provide a signed letter from your GP on letter-headed paper confirming: type of your vaccine, batch number and the dates you were given the vaccine.</li> <li>6. In case you had Covid-19, please provide a proof of positive test result and negative test result (PCR test only) from when were sick.</li> <li>7. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol>
<p>Spouse of an Israeli Citizen (Married)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of spouse's Israeli passport</li> <li>3. Marriage certificate</li> <li>4. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>5. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol>
<p>Partner of an Israeli Citizen (Not married)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of partner's Israeli passport</li> <li>3. Proofs of relationship - joint bank account, joint bills, joint tenancy agreement/mortgage, flight tickets from previous holidays, photos etc. (at least 4 proofs are needed)</li> <li>4. Signed declaration form(see link in our website)</li> <li>5. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol>
<p>Minor children of an Israeli Citizen –</p> <p><b>Parents who apply for this permit must register their child as an Israeli citizen upon returning from Israel.</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of the applying parent's Israeli passport</li> <li>2. Copy of the child's passport</li> <li>3. Proof of a family connection - please send a copy of the Birth Certificate with both parents' names on the document</li> <li>4. Child registration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>5. Parents declaration (see link in our website)</li> <li>6. Parents' marriage certificate</li> <li>7. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>8. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol> <p>*if the children are traveling with one parent only, the other parent must give his/her consent stating they consent to only one parent travelling to Israel with their children. Please submit an affidavit <b><u>signed by a public Notary.</u></b></p>

<p>Funeral (only first degree family members without accompanying spouses)</p> <p>can arrive for 24 hours ONLY</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of the deceased family member's Israeli passport</li> <li>3. Death certificate (if the body being transferred to Israel – please submit a form of burial approval in Israel as well)</li> <li>4. Proof of family relations must be made by sending birth certificates with both parents names as proof, and marriage certificate</li> <li>5. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>6. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> <li>7.</li> </ol>
<p>Wedding- Only parents of the bride/groom can request entry, if not vaccinated</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passports</li> <li>2. Copy of the bride and groom's Israeli passport/ passport + visa/ passport</li> <li>3. Birth certificate with both parents' names</li> <li>4. Signed Rabbanut opening file letter, with the wedding date stated</li> <li>5. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>6. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol>
<p>Birth of a <u>grandchild</u> – Only who is <b>vaccinated with two doses</b> or has <b>antibodies</b>, is eligible to submit a request to enter Israel.</p> <p><b>1 month before the due date and 1 month after the birth ONLY</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passports</li> <li>2. Copy of child's Israeli passport \ foreign passport + visa</li> <li>3. Proof of a family connection to your child - a copy of the Birth Certificate with both parents' names on the document</li> <li>4. If the child changed their surname after marriage – marriage certificate</li> <li>5. Proof of a family connection to your grandchild– a copy of the Birth Certificate with both parents' names on the document</li> <li>6. Hospital medical report with the due date</li> <li>7. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>8. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol>
<p>Students</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of your visa/acceptance letter from a University in Israel</li> <li>3. "Purple Badge" – the Israeli Ministry of Health's certificate issued for the specific University/ higher education institution.</li> <li>4. Signed declaration form (see link in our website)</li> <li>5. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li> </ol> <p>*if you are applying for new student visa you are required to submit additional documents. Please send the application to <a href="mailto:consul-sec@london.mfa.gov.il">consul-sec@london.mfa.gov.il</a>.</p>
<p>Yeshiva Students (old, new and adults)</p>	<p>The Yeshiva is required to be in contact with the Israeli Population and Immigration Authority, which will directly provide the Consulate with the full list of students.</p>
<p>Humanitarian reasons – First degree family members ONLY</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of your passport</li> <li>2. Copy of your first degree family member's Israeli passport/ for residents only (do not have an Israeli passport) please provide copy of your passport + visa</li> <li>3. Proof of a family connection must be made by sending Birth Certificates with both parents' names as proof and marriage certificate</li> </ol>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. Up to date medical report from the doctor/ hospital explaining the patient's condition</li><li>6. Proof of travel insurance (must contain Covid-19 clause)</li><li>7. Signed declaration form*</li></ol>
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
