A bilateral Agreement between Israel and New Zealand, Australia, Germany, Korea, the Czech Republic and Austria in the future will sign with other countries around the world granting you the opportunity to combine a relaxing vacation, explore an exciting new culture and lifestyle – with the option to work during your trip.

So many places to go: Non-stop Tel-Aviv, Holy Jerusalem and Tiberias, Nazareth, Ancient Acre, the Dead Sea and more – Just choose!

How to apply?

Simple: Fill out these forms\* (link to the application) and send the Embassy of Israel in the country of origin, using mail or E-mail, fax or by personal attendance. You can search the web-site for the contact information: http://mfa.gov.il/MFAHEB/ConsularService/Pages/default.aspx

## Before registration, please review the Terms and Conditions:

- The passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the date of departure to Israel.
- Applicants must be between 18-30 years of age.
- The filled out application is to be submitted only at the Embassy of Israel in the country of origin.
- The program is allowed once per person and with no accompanying family members. The period of stay must not exceed 12 months.
- The applicant should submit a document of integrity.
- Every participant must be able to purchase a return flight ticket.
- Participants must carry abroad a reasonable amount of money that can sustain
- Medical insurance for the duration of stay in Israel.

Your request will be examined by the local Embassy, and if all goes well you will be invited to receive your Israel B1 Working Holiday Visa for multiple entrances, allowing you to travel and work in Israel.

When attending the Israeli Embassy at the set date please bring with you:-

- Your passport as well as a photocopy of the first pages.
- · Police certificate of integrity, or police clearance
- · Proof of medical insurance valid for the entire stay of one year.
- · An application form for the work-travel visa to Israel
- Recites or approval for all fees (Hyperlink)

It is important to indicate that the Working Holiday Program is not meant to be for individuals who are already in Israel as tourists/students or on any other visa type in Israel.
